Boil Water Notice Rescinded
05/05/25

This Notice applies only to customers along SE CO 3030 and SE CR 3032 to which the original boiled water notice was issued. No other customers were affected.

On 05/01/25 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the MEN WSC public water system, 1750015, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of 05/05/25.

If you have questions concerning this matter, you may contact Dennis Donoho at 903-872-1899. A BT sample was taken on 05/01/25 and delivered to the City of Waco Lab on 5/2/25 with negative results provided to MEN WSC on 05/05/25.
